## Ground Water: a new project by Andreco on view at SpazioC21, Reggio **Emilia**

On view form March to May 2021, "Ground Water" is a project by Andreco (Rome, 1978), exhibited in the courtyard and in the windows of SpazioC21 at Palazzo Brami, Reggio Emilia.

The group of works - made up of four large canvases and a sculptural installation staged in the center of the courtyard deals with the theme of water, its life and its shortage. The works express the artist's investigation on a extremely



contemporary theme in our society: the effects of climate change on the environment in which we live.

This reflection by Andreco upon the meaning of water, integrated into the topic of environmental sustainability and of the climate changes - at the center of his artistic practice - aware the observer to his responsibility towards the environment. The drop of water is a metaphor for life; its absence is end of the same!
